Mayor 2016/17 - Cllr Chris Lines



Councillor Chris Lines was appointed the Mayor of Sedgefield in May 2016.

"I'm hugely honoured to have been appointed to this role. I have lived in Sedgefield for most of my life, as have many of my family. I loved growing up here, was later married here and now I run a business in the Manor House in the centre of the town, and my wife and I are bringing up our own children here too. There have been changes in Sedgefield over the years and, inevitably, more are on the horizon. However, there has always been a really strong community spirit here and it's really important that we sustain that for this and future generations. As Mayor of Sedgefield, I aim to play my role in doing so over the next 12 months. I hope that residents and businesses will be keen to work with me on events and initiatives that will benefit some very deserving charities and I will welcome any offers of support."

Chris Lines raised money during the year for three specific charities:

- The Lullaby Trust, which provides specialist support for bereaved families and anyone affected by a sudden infant death. The trust has been chosen in memory of local girl Alice Robinson, who passed away in November 2015 aged just 11 months. Alice was the daughter of Sedgefield residents William and Katy Robinson, good friends of the mayor and his family.
- The Sir Bobby Robson Foundation, in memory of his mother Margaret Lines, who died in 2009 after a brave battle with cancer. Lines received care at the Freeman Hospital in Newcastle, where much of the foundation's work is focused.
- Friends of Sedgefield Harriers (FoSH), a charity that was founded to support amateur sport and improve sports provision in Sedgefield. FoSH is leading the campaign to build training facilities in Sedgefield that will benefit the hundreds of young people in Sedgefield who participate in sport.

During his year as mayor, Chris Lines raised an incredible £7,200 towards his three chosen charities – The Lullaby Trust, Sir Bobby Robson Foundation, Friends of Sedgefield Harriers – and other local organisations.
